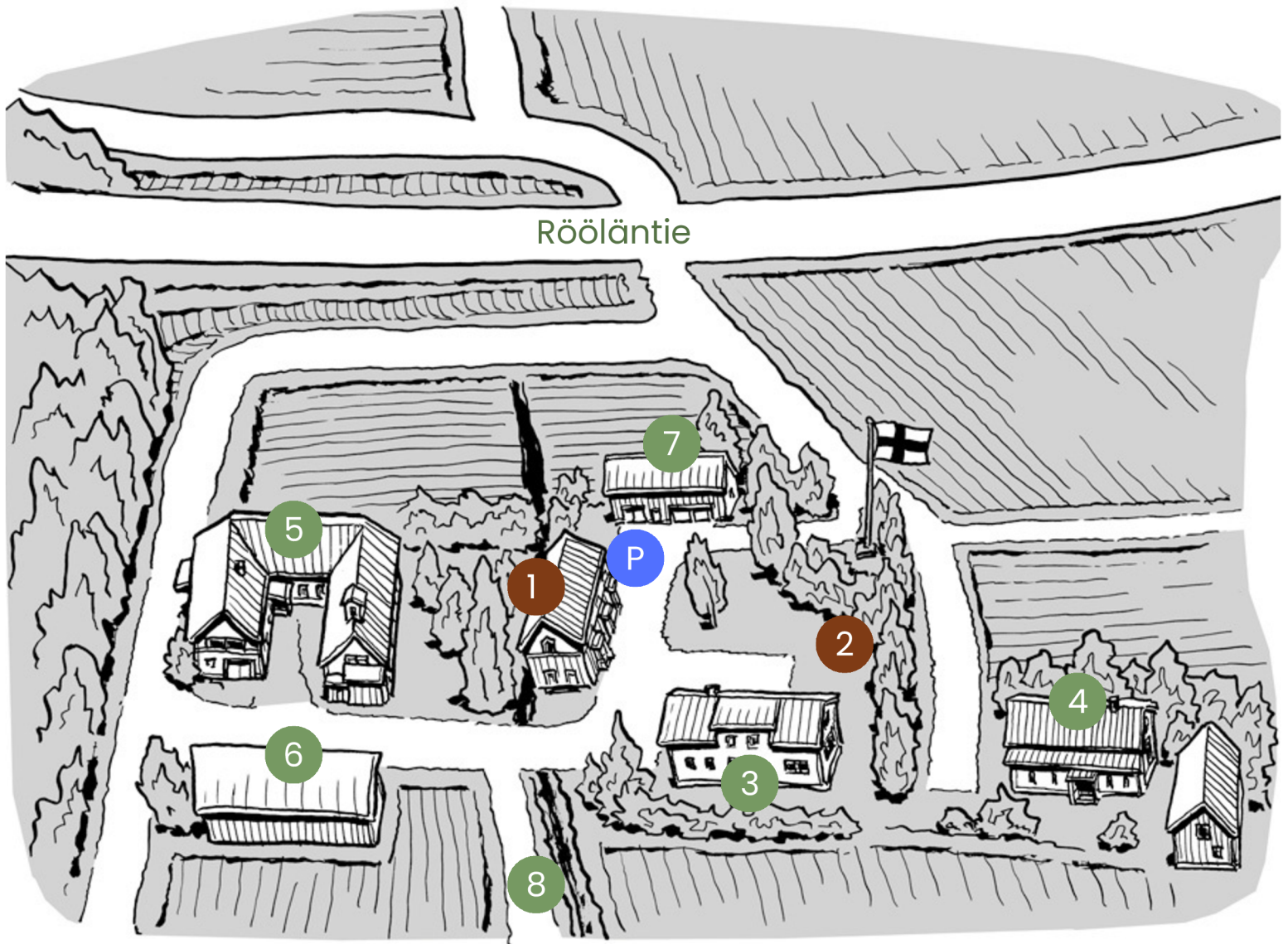

# WELCOME!

## HERE'S WHAT TO KNOW WHEN YOU ARRIVE

- You can park in the yard next to the Airbnb.
- Check-in starts at 3 PM and check-out is by 11 AM on the day of departure.
- Quiet hours are from 10 PM to 7 AM (our children go to bed around 8 PM).
- Please remove your shoes in the entrance area, both in the accommodation and washroom facilities.
- The toilet is for guests only, and the shower facilities are shared with us. Guest towels are placed on the beds
- All water comes from our own well – it's fresh and completely safe to drink, both in the summer kitchen and at the sauna.
- You can fetch warm dishwashing water from the sauna with a bucket. Please use water sparingly!
- This is our home, and we are around most of the time, so if you're missing anything, don't hesitate to ask!





## SHOWER AND TOILET



The sauna and shower are also used by our family. For fire safety reasons, the sauna can only be used when we are at home. If you'd like to enjoy the sauna, just let us know.

The freezing EcoHytte compost toilet is reserved for guests only and is emptied between each stay. Please do not put anything non-biodegradable into the toilet. If the toilet is full, let us know.

Guest bath towels can be found in the rooms – each guest has one bath towel and one hand towel reserved for them.

**We kindly ask you to leave your shoes at the entrance, both in the sleeping areas and in the washroom.**

# FERRY M/S ÖSTERN

From Rymättylä, you can travel by sea from Hanka harbor to the islands of Seili and Nauvo. The passenger-car ferry m/s Östern operates this route three times a day during the summer season, from May 9 to September 14, 2025.

Reservations are not needed, and vehicles are boarded in the order of arrival.

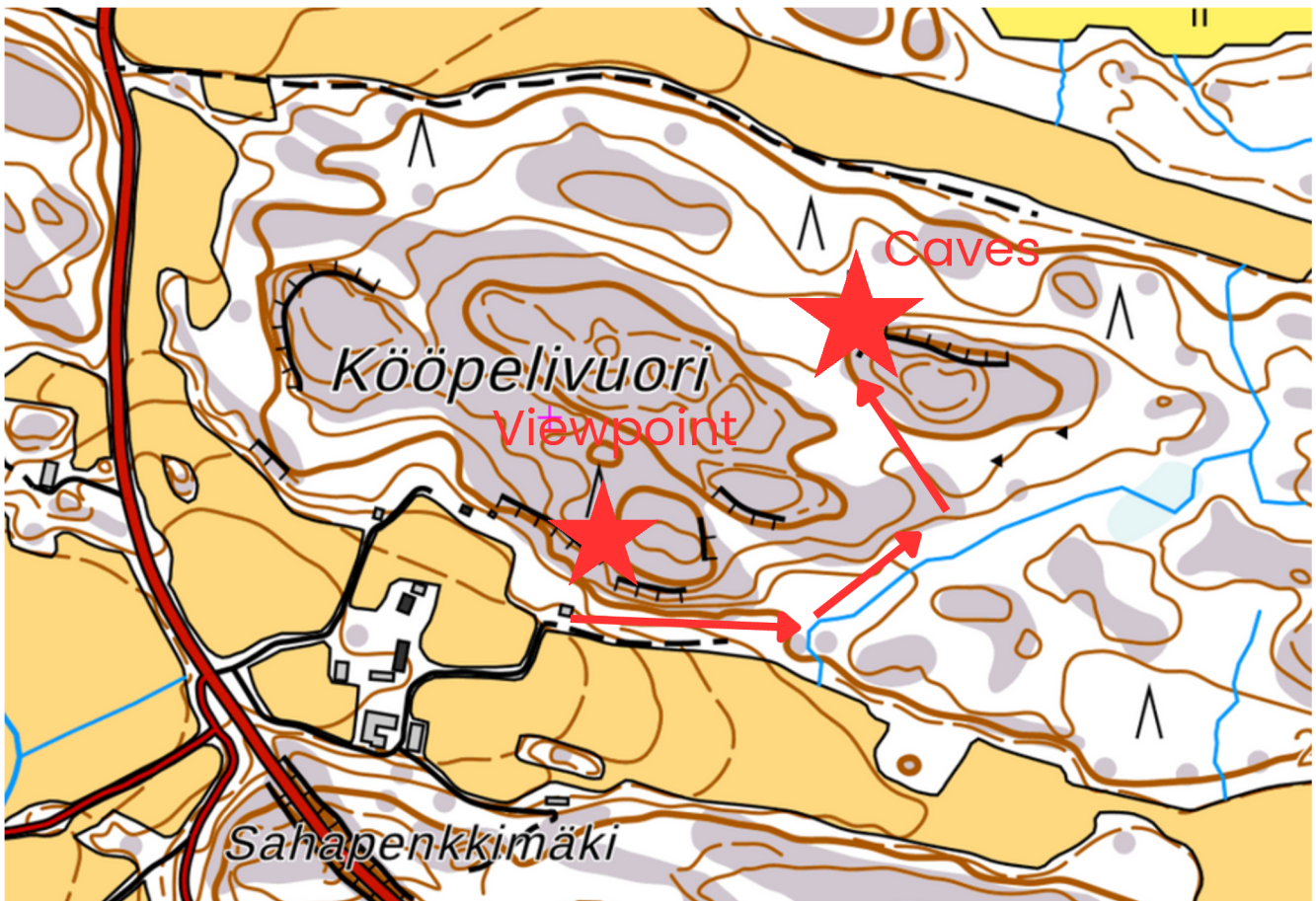


# FOREST TRAIL TO KETTUKALLIO CAVES

We've marked the trail to the Kettukallio caves with red ribbons. The walk from the house is less than a kilometer: start at the grain dryer and follow the edge of the field. When you see a red ribbon on the forest road, turn left onto the path.

If you'd like to take in the views over the fields and forest — and don't mind a bit of climbing — you can hike up the rocky hill behind the grain dryer.

Please don't light any fires in the forest without permission, and remember to take your trash with you. Let's keep nature beautiful and safe for everyone.





# GRILL AND GAS BURNER INSTRUCTIONS



## TURN ON THE GAS BOTTLE.

The gas bottles are located in the lower cabinet. There is also a spare bottle in the cabinet in case the gas runs out.

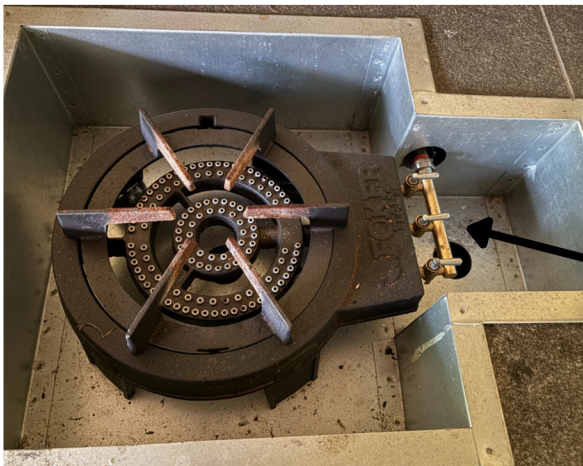
Reminder: Turn off the gas bottles after use.



## LIGHTING THE GRILL

You don't need a flame to light the grill – it ignites using the ignition button on the front edge.

Adjust the flame with the control knobs. The fifth knob controls the upper-level heater.



## LIGHTING THE GAS BURNER

The gas burner is ignited using a lighter or matches. First, open the gas valve(s) on the burner ring.

You can also use a cast-iron frying pan on the gas burner. In that case, use only the center burner ring.

Note: Please clean the grill and the griddle pan after use, once they have cooled down.

Kepuinen was first mentioned in historical records as early as 1335. By 1540, there were two farms in the village: Päivätalo (also known as Meritalo) and Pohjatalo. Erik Wahlroos from Naantali purchased Päivätalo in 1875 and Pohjatalo the following year. Since then, both farms have been owned by the same family – the current owner represents the fifth generation.

The main house, built from logs in 1900, is a traditional Finnish paritupa (double-room farmhouse), originally consisting of a living room chamber, a front chamber, and a porch chamber. The impressive three-board ceiling and exposed beams in the main room reflect the style of the era. Beneath the house is a cellar, accessible also from the outside.

In 1959, the house underwent a major renovation: some interior walls were removed, bedrooms and an indoor toilet were added upstairs, and the old saddle-roofed porch was replaced with a new open porch with a single-sloped roof. In 2023, the facade of the main house was restored to its original early 20th-century appearance, complete with a glass porch featuring original windows.

According to the Suuri maatilakirja (Great Farm Book), the outbuilding, small cottage, and loft were built in 1905. However, the oldest parts – such as the loft – likely date back to the mid-1800s. The outbuilding was renovated into its current form in 1958. On the west side stands a storage building from 1952. The cattle barn, built from fired brick in 1920, once housed 17 cows, five horses, a pigsty, a chicken coop, and feed storage. An AIV tower (for silage) was added later. Today, the building is used for storage.
